The New River Valley Fair 4-H Share the Fun Talent Showcase is open to 4-H youth, ages 9-18, from the counties of Bland, Carroll, Floyd, Giles, Montgomery, Pulaski, and Wythe, who were participants at their 4-H County Share the Fun Talent Showcase.

Eligible 4-Her's must receive signed and verified consent from their 4-H Agent or 4-H Program Assistant to register for the contest. The 4-H Agent or 4-H Program Assistant will then fax or mail the 4-Her's registration to the Pulaski County 4-H Office. Registrations must be received in the Pulaski County 4-H Office no later than Wednesday, July 15, 2015. The contest is open to the first 20 acts, taken on a first come, first registered basis. Contestants are responsible for providing all props, music, instruments (to include pianos and keyboards), etc., needed to perform. Sound system will be provided by Pulaski County 4-H. All contestants across all categories will compete against each other. Prize money and/or awards/trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
