

**Virginia Showmaster & Jackpot Rules**  
**July 28, 2018**



1. Open to youth exhibitors to 19 years of age and younger.
2. Market lambs may be ewe lambs and/or wether lambs. Wethers must show no evidence of testicular tissue and be completely healed from castration.
3. Market lambs must be exhibited shorn slick to the skin above the knee and hock joints.
4. The use of coloring agents is prohibited.
5. Exhibitors are expected to care for their animals in an acceptable manner and adhere to quality assurance guidelines.
6. Market lambs will be weighed and classes will be divided according to weight. Re-weighs will not be allowed. Class weight breaks and division assignments (light weight, middle weight, and heavy weight) will be made at the discretion of the show officials. Division champions and reserves will compete for the Grand Champion and Reserve Champion honors.
7. All Showman must be registered exhibitors in the show and show their own animals. Unless, in the event of an exhibitor having 2 or more animals in the same class and/or division/champion drives. In that event, only another registered exhibitor with animals in the show may assist the showman. Any violators will be disqualified.
8. In order for an exhibitor to compete in the junior, intermediate and senior showmanship divisions, an exhibitor is required to use their own animal that is registered in their name in the show. The pee-wee showmanship division is the only division that is exempt from this rule. Any violators will be disqualified.
9. Weigh in for lambs will be on Saturday morning from 8:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. Show will begin at 12:30 pm.
10. Lambs will be released at 9:00 p.m. on Saturday night.
